



Air Passenger Rights following the United Kingdom's withdrawal from the European Union.

As from 2359 hours on 31 December 2020, following the UK's withdrawal from the EU, Regulation EC261/2004 (EC261), ceased to apply.

However, in place of this Regulation, is the Air Passenger Rights and Air Travel Organisers' Licensing (Amendment) (EU Exit) Regulations 2019 (APR Regulations) (UK261).

UK261 retains much of the content of the previously used EU261, however, there are two significant changes to be aware of:

1 The fixed compensation values are now in sterling, as opposed to Euros:

Flight Length	Compensation Amount
Short-haul flights of under 1,500km	£220
Mid-haul flights of 1,500km – 3,500km	£350
Long-haul flights of over 3,500km	£520
Long haul flights of over 3,500km	£260 (for flights arriving at the final destination with a delay of under four hours)

2 Flights both to and from Gibraltar are now covered by UK261, whereas previously, there were restrictions on these flights.
